**COVID Update /Relief** -Pop up testing is occurring throughout the County and at the Cloverdale Plaza on Thursday mornings. a Sonoma County Department of Public Health (DPH) is providing Flu Vaccinations and COVID Testing on Saturday, December 5<sup>th</sup>. The pop-up testing will target the Tarman neighborhood. Attached is a copy of the flyer prepared by DPH. Here are the details:

**Proposed Evacuation Zones-** Chief Ferguson announced that the Cloverdale Police Department completed preparation of draft evacuation zones for the City of Cloverdale. These zones are designed to provide an orderly evacuation of Cloverdale in the event of an emergency. A total of 8 zones are identified. At this point, Chief Ferguson is seeking comments, after which the County of Sonoma will review and approve. Eventually the zones will be incorporated into the County's evacuation zones.

**CURA Project Update:** Gabriel Sanders from La Plaza, a subsidiary of On the Move, is a County of Sonoma designated non-profit charged with outreach for Covid-19 for Latinx community provided Resilient Cloverdale an overview of the CURA Project. He explained the urgent need and response for aid occurring in the Latinx community. La Plaza is aiding people needing to quarantine and all the ancillary needs associated with it. To date, over 300 families have been helped receiving an assistance amount ranging from \$1700, to \$3,000. On the Move and La Plaza are looking for additional funding to continuing their efforts through 2021. Other services include family resources, legal aid, paid sick leave, and mental health. Attached are the flowchart flyer/posters for use by the public in Spanish and English.

- CURA was designed by front-line staff that have existing relationships with the individuals and communities served by the Project. These individuals are representative of the communities that they serve and are exceptionally talented at partnering with the community to create just and equitable programming. CURA involves a large-scale outreach effort, connection to a medical home, in-home support for those isolating and quarantining, and financial support for those who qualify. The overarching aims of CURA are: to educate community members on the dangers of COVID-19; to ensure that community members receive the support they need in order to keep themselves and their families safe; and provide the emotional and financial support necessary for families to safely quarantine within their homes if they have been exposed to the virus.

Through the work of multiple agencies, resource fairs, localized training and outreach in the fields CURA will reach and provide the Latinx and other Indigenous community members with education and updates on the COVID-19 Pandemic.

- **Charla program:**

OVERVIEW: Charla was developed by Dr. Miguel Tirado and several other leaders in other counties as an onsite training for employees and their supervisors to guarantee the highest level of COVID-19 safety in the workplace. Guided by community health advocates and health care professionals, a CHARLA session consists of:

- A 40 minute on-site orientation for workers on COVID-19 and how to take greater responsibility for preventing the spread of the epidemic
- An on- line training of field supervisors to learn how to be watchful for signs of symptoms of the virus and how to safeguard other workers
- Assignment of a trained health care advocate who is regularly available to answer any questions that designated supervisors may have
- Automated text messaging sent to employees and those with whom they live on how to guard against the virus at home. (This is important because the spread of COVID-19 occurs primarily in the home environment which can spread to the worksite.)

TIMING OF SESSIONS: 40-minute CHARLA sessions should be conducted with an audience of no more than 20 employees at a time. We can schedule multiple sessions in a day for different worker shifts or multiple sessions in a week depending on your company's needs.
