

**Artisan / Tent Guidelines:**

-Artisans are limited to selling merchandise of a “homemade” nature...goods made by hand from a local, skilled worker that are limited in quantity...not factory produced or made in mass quantities.

-It is a requirement that all artisans and food vendors obtain a Sellers Permit and or Food Permit. The cost for selling at the Festival is \$40 for artisans and \$50 for food vendors, which is non-refundable once a commitment is made.

-Each artisan will be assigned an area for only one 8’ table which they will bring. There can be as many as 6 artisans in each tent grouping of 3 tents. It will be up to the individuals in the group to arrange the tables beneficial to all artisans.

-Name of the artisan or merchandise can be displayed on the table or tablecloth but cannot be hanging from the upper cross bar of the tents.

-Traditional Posada Navidena décor can be used to decorate Fiesta Navidena tents

-Except for a limited number of food vendors generators are not allowed.

-Artisans can bring their own heaters but they cannot plug into the tent lighting. They should bring battery powered lanterns or headlamps.

-Power hookups for the tents will be managed by the Chamber.

-Each grouping of tents will be decorated with lighting, garlands and olive branches, which will be provided by the Chamber.
